The project was launched during the coronavirus lockdown by the NGO Parki Ar Minda [Geo. I don't want a bag] to help people who couldn't bring their waste to collection points, which were closed due to the quarantine.

We launched the Eco-Taxi service as a response to closed collection points during the [coronavirus] lockdown. With time, we realized that there is a demand for such services even when collection points reopened," said Mariam Pesvianidze, Co-founder of Parki Ar Minda.

Several members of parliament have initiated amendments to the code of waste management, according to which the individuals who deliberately burn municipal waste, including leaves, garden/park waste, domestic waste in the open air or inside an inappropriate burning device, will be fined by 500 GEL (\$178).

The Georgian parliament has approved tougher penalties for violations of the Waste Management Code for polluting the environment with animal and inert (building, demolition waste, sand, gravel, stone) waste.

Tbilisi"s Mziuri Park came alive on 30 March as hundreds of people gathered to celebrate the International Day of Zero Waste, marking a step towards a cleaner, greener, and healthier lifestyle in Georgia.

In Georgia, plastic production and imports have surged by 71 percent over the past decade, resulting in widespread illegal dumpsites, particularly in rural areas. Plastic accountsfor over 95 percent of litter accumulated on Georgia's beaches. In 2020, up to 93 percent of produced and imported plastic items in
