Just because you're traveling off the grid in a van doesn't mean you have to stay away from electronics completely. There will inevitably be times where you need to power certain appliances, like your cell phone, your campervan fridge, or even your toilet!

Renogy is one of the biggest names in the van life community, and for a good reason. They produce some of the highest-rated solar panels, battery chargers, and controllers for camper van and RV owners. So why wouldn't they also make some of the best power inverter chargers too?

The Renogy 1000W Pure Sine Converter is one of the best campervan pure sine wave inverters we've seen. It produces up to 1000W of continuous power and a whopping 2000W of peak/surge power, which should be more than sufficient for handling most mid-size appliances within your van conversion.

Not only is the unit quiet (it comes with a cooling fan), but it also has an ECO-saving mode to reduce power consumption when nothing is plugged in. If you live off-grid or rely on a small battery, this ECO-saving mode is a lifesaver.

The Renogy 3000W Inverter may not be the cheapest 12v campervan inverter on this list, but it's easily the most robust. Providing an astonishing 3000-watt continuous output with 9000W surge power output, this pure sine wave inverter has a 90% efficiency rating, making it one of the most powerful models on the market.

It comes with a built-in LCD screen, so you can easily program and monitor its usage. In addition, it's loaded with safety features like overload, overcharge, over-discharge, short circuit, and over-temperature protection.

The two biggest downsides for us are 1) the price and 2) the wired remote. Smaller, less powerful Renogy models have a Bluetooth connectivity option, which is mysteriously lacking in this more expensive product.

Boasting 1800 watts of continuous pure sine wave power, the Xantrex Prowatt 806 inverter is a solid choice for your van conversion. The peak power also clocks in at 3000 watts, which may be lower compared to other power inverters of this size.

However, it should be more than capable of powering demanding electrical loads like microwaves, power tools, and other high voltage devices. And 85% - 90% efficient rating means you'll waste less free electricity.

Xantrex is a reputable brand in the RV and van world, and their top-notch customer service is one of their biggest selling points. If you need to exchange the unit under the company's impressive 2-year warranty, then you can easily reach them through phone or email for your replacement.

It comes with three AC outlets and two USB ports, so you'll have no problem hooking up multiple devices to the power supply. And to help you monitor the power status, this inverter also has a low battery alarm, automatic shutdown, and power and fault lights.
