The Egyptian Electricity Holding Company is a state-owned company for electrical power generation, transmission and distribution in Egypt.[1] It was established in 2000 and works in the field of production, transmission and distribution of electricity in Egypt.[2] It supervises production stations, transmission networks, and electricity distribution networks, and includes 16 subsidiaries.

The Egyptian Electricity Holding Company was established in 1976 under the name "Egypt Electricity Authority" to be responsible for all electrical power stations and transmission and distribution networks. In 1984, the Public Sector Authority for Electrical Power Distribution was established, and it assumed supervision of electricity distribution companies.[3]
