For details on charging costs at specific locations, click on the pin icon on the map. You'll find a cost field that shows pricing information reported by other charger users. In some instances, pricing details may be mentioned in the charger's description. Please note that pricing information may not be accessible for certain locations.

To identify Tesla-compatible charging stations, simply click on a specific station pin on the map. Check for information about the available connectors; Tesla-compatible stations will typically list Tesla-specific connectors. You can also explore user reviews and comments for insights.

The score given to a charging station reflects user experiences on a scale of 1 to 10, with 10 being the highest rating. Negative experiences reported by users result in a lower station score, while positive experiences lead to a higher score. Neutral comments or check-ins do not impact the overall score. Additionally, reading comments for each location can provide deeper insights into the basis for each score. You can access PlugScores via the Station Summary icon on the map.

If you are an electric vehicle (EV) user looking for a charge, you can now pull up to new charging stations added at four City facilities. The stations are free to use as part of the City's new pilot program.

"With Council adoption of the Winnipeg Climate Action Plan, there was an opportunity to support the adoption of zero emission vehicles by increasing the availability of electric vehicle charging infrastructure in public spaces," said Lindsay Mierau, Manager of the Office of Sustainability.

More and more people are driving more sustainable vehicles like hybrids and electric cars. There are many electric vehicle charging stations Winnipeg has to offer to accommodate our growing population of environmentally-conscious drivers.

West of the main entrance, IKEA has four J1772 charging ports to support electric vehicles. They're a level 2 charge and free to use but you have to activate the port through the ChargePoint website or app. IKEA has charging stations at all their locations across Canada.

There are two charging ports in the Winnipeg Square parkade: one level 2 for Teslas and one level 2

non-networked J1772. Both ports are free to use (though you still have to pay to park) and are conveniently located indoors. While you're at it, you can get a car wash in the parkade.

The Forks has a spot with a J1772 port--free to charge--but it's not a dedicated EV spot. You can find it near The Original Pancake House entrance. Friendly reminder: parking is still \$2.00 an hour.

If you're stopping at the mall, why not charge up your EV? This is known as the Winnipeg Supercharger station as they have eight level 3 Tesla Supercharger ports, all free to use. The Tesla ports are located in the parking section behind Earls. There are also the following EV ports located in the parkade in front of the Starbucks entrance: J1772, CCS/SAE and CHAdeMO. The level 2 chargers cost \$1.50 per hour and if you want fast-charging, it'll cost you \$20 per hour (but parking is free).

While you're studying at Red River College, it's nice to know you can leave with a fully charged EV. The college has ports off Skinner Road: two level 2 J1772 ports and one level 3 CHAdeMO port--both free to use.
