

Electric vehicle costs Spain

Electric vehicles are most expensive in Navarre, for example where a second-hand model would cost an average of 35,579 euros. In Andalusia, the average price for a second-hand electric vehicle is just 24,329 euros. When considering the price of an electric car in Spain, you need to consider more than just the purchase price.

EV incentives in Spain are mainly regulated by the Moves II and Moves III plans: Moves III: A EUR400-million program, which can raise to EUR800-million, that aims to be the most ambitious line of support for electric mobility.

Although the range of an electric car depends on the model - there are some that can drive 500km on a charge of 100kWh - travelling by EV works out at between EUR30 and EUR40 for 50kWh while a ...

It's worth checking out your regional incentives, as some may offer extra subsidies. For more information on your local EV incentives, a quick internet search of "Incentivos de veh?culos el?ctricos + [nombre de su ?rea]" ("EV incentives + [name of your area]") should point you in the right direction. Most regions will allow you to apply online, via their government website.

Under the Moves II plan, private individuals and businesses can receive grants between 30-40% (up to a total sum of EUR100,000) of the purchase and installation cost of public or private chargers.
