A low rolling resistance has been achieved through specially constructed compound. Within the tyre's compound elastomer-filler coupling works to greatly reduce energy loss, which lowers rolling resistance - resulting in less fuel or electricity needed to move.

Michelin have designed the e.Primacy with a thinner top belt, that is capable of delivering the same resistance with less raw material. As a result, the e.Primacy generates less rolling resistance overall.

Summer tyres are specifically designed for warm weather conditions, particularly during the summer season. This type of tyre performs best when in seasons with warmer temperatures - above 7°C.

The technologies and tread patterns used in a summer tyre mean the tyres have high-quality features that are of benefit to driving in warm conditions. They typically use a softer rubber compound - designed for good grip and traction when driving on dry and wet roads.

Whilst summer tyres still offer adequate performances in wet and cooler conditions, it is recommended that you change. The tread design and technologies that are featured in summer tyres can harden in colder temperatures, resulting in reduced flexibility and decreased traction on snow and ice.

For the advice of your specific manufacturer, please check your owner's manual.

For front or rear-wheel drive vehicles, it's advised that you change tyres in axle pairs - either both of the rear or front tyres for optimum performance on the road. Plus, when you order two or more tyres, there's no charge for mobile tyre fitting, so it'll save money and keep your tyres even.

We always recommend that you replace all four tyres at the same time, unless you require a puncture repair. At a minimum, we strongly advise all customers to always replace tyres across the same axle - either both of the rear or front tyres for optimum performance on the road.
