

Myanmar electricity rates

Rate of Electricity. Public Announcement from Ministry of Electricity and Energy changes to electricity rates. The electricity rates across Myanmar will be amended to the following rates, outlined in the table, beginning from 1 July 2019.

Public Notice Amendment to electricity bill rates. 1. Access to electricity plays a crucial role in the country's social and economic development, and the Ministry of Electric Power upgrades the power plants and power grids. It also conducts extensions and maintenance works in collaboration with local and foreign investments.

Minister Office New. MoEE organizes meeting over works on energy sector. THE Ministry of Electricity and Energy organized a coordination meeting over its present and future works on the energy sector at the ministry in Nay Pyi Taw yesterday.

The residential electricity price in Burma (Myanmar) is MMK 60.500 per kWh or USD 0.019. The electricity price for businesses is MMK 164.700 kWh or USD 0.051. These retail prices were collected in March 2024 and include the cost of power, distribution and transmission, and all taxes and fees.

Amid a floundering economy and soaring food prices, Myanmar's military council announced on Friday via regime-controlled newspapers that the rates charged for electricity will increase in September.

As listed by the junta-controlled ministry of electric power, the rates before the change were between 35 and 125 kyat (US \$0.02 and \$0.06) per unit for households and between 125 and 180 kyat (US \$0.06 and \$0.09) per unit for businesses.

The rates for businesses, industrial facilities, and the offices of embassies, consulates, and international organisations will increase to 250 kyat (US \$0.12) per unit for the first 5,000 units, 400 kyat (US \$0.19) per unit for 5,001 to 20. . .

YANGON: The Ministry of Electric Power (MOEP) announced on Friday (Aug 30) that electricity bills will be increased, from the previous maximum of 125 kyats to 300 kyats for household use and from the previous maximum of 180 kyats to 500 kyats for commercial use starting September 1.

According to the agreement of the Union Cabinet Meeting No.5/2024 held on July 5, 2024, the electricity rates will be 50 kyats for household use from 1 to 50 units, 100 kyats from 51 to 100 units, 150 kyats from 101 to 200 units, and 300 kyats from 201 units and above.
