In observance of the Thanksgiving Day holiday, DOB will be closed on Thursday and Friday, November 28 and 29, 2024; no construction will be allowed on Thursday without an after-hours permit. As electrical codes change to meet changing technologies, you may find your home or business is no longer in compliance. For a new construction home, the first round of the inspection is known as the "rough-in" and looks at construction as it's being done, after electrical work has been done but before insulation and drywall are installed. The second inspection is known as the "final inspection" and will ensure everything is installed properly and functioning safely.

The inspection process is slightly different if you have an existing home and are doing major renovations, but your inspection will still focus on electrical safety and the proper installation of all wiring, circuits, outlets and switches.

Electrical inspections come in a variety of forms, but they always fall into one of three categories. The first is a rough electrical examination, which will look at cables, conduits and electrical panels and boxes. An inspector will ensure that all wires are in good condition and that all fire risks around conduits and electrical panels have been removed.

The service inspection is the second sort of electrical examination. A qualified inspector will examine the

electrical service panel during this inspection to check that it has been correctly installed and secured. During this time, the inspector will also verify the electrical service panel to ensure that it is properly grounded. You face the danger of electric shock if your panel isn't properly grounded.

The third and final inspection is referred to as the final inspection. Breakers will be installed or tested during installation to guarantee a fully working electrical system. An inspector may run the electrical system through a series of tests to ensure its safety and efficacy.

Yes, electrical inspections are a legal requirement. While the small details in regulations and requirements may vary from state to state, all 50 states have some form of electrical inspection standards for all new construction.

Electrical examinations look at your home's power capacity and safety. To put it another way, can your home safely meet the power demands you place on it? A professional electrical inspection will detect any possible problems with your electrical system that might put your family in danger, such as defective wiring, toxic chemicals, overloaded fuses or circuit boxes that could cause an electrical fire. It's also against the law to not have an inspection.
